


## Judging at Great Dane Club of North Central Florida Leon Reimert

My Winners Dog and Best of Winners, Harmon WYSIWYG's Karma and Effect was a blue puppy from the 9-12 Class. He had a beautiful head and neck with a solid topline. He exhibited a lot of breed type.



Reserve Winners Dog, Romance's Promises Kept ABW V KRW was a mantle from the Open Class. He had lots of substance, solid topline and moved well.

My Winners Bitch, Asbury Blackstone Brooklyn Bridge V Jerdans was fawn from the American Bred Class. She had a classic head and long arched neck. She also exhibited a lot of breed type.

Reserve Winners Bitch, McEmn's Sparkle Plenty was a fawn the Open Class. She was very well balanced with good movement and a solid topline.

My Best of Breed, GCh Longo Miller N Lore's Diamond Lil was a stunning black bitch. She was exuberant in breed type with a beautiful head and neck, solid topline, good substance and very well balanced. This all contributed to her excellent movement.

Best of Opposite, Ch Legacys Killer Instinct TT was a brindle dog with a beautiful head, solid topline and a real showman.

Select Dog, GCh Echolane-Darlin's Beyond A Shadow of a Doubt was a fawn with a nice head, solid topline and very well balanced.

Select Bitch, Ch Raintree Erinwood Dixie for Heaven's Sake was a beautiful brindle with a very pretty head, good topline, moved and showed very well.

My Award of Merit went to the Veteran Bitch 8+ yrs, Ch Kandu's Summer Rain RN. She had a classic head and expression, solid topline and moved very well for a 9 year old dane.
